

**Company Morning Reports**

1<sup>st</sup> Sergeants deliver to Battalion Headquarters each morning (time subject to change). Subsequent changes (gains or losses) should be communicated to Headquarters at the earliest opportunity.

Identify names of qualified medical personnel within company.

Identify names of individuals with pre-existing medical conditions Headquarters should be aware of.

**Medical Emergency**

Repeatedly call out signal of "MEDIC" to identify actual injuries suffered during engagements. Report all actual injuries to Battalion Headquarters following engagement.

**Lost & Found**

Report lost items to Battalion Headquarters. Turn in all found items to Battalion Headquarters.

**Safety Infractions**

Notify Battalion staff immediately if a severe infraction occurs during an engagement. Report incident to Battalion Headquarters as soon as practical following the engagement if the incident is of minor consequence.

- By the right of Companies to the Rear (Front)
- Form Column by Company, on the X Company, Right (Left) in Front, Battalion (L/R/I) Face
- Change Front Forward on First (Last) Company, By Company Right (Left) Half Wheel
- Forward Into Line, By Company Left (Right) Half Wheel
- Deploy Column on X Company, Battalion (L/R/O) Face



## Map

- No vehicles allowed in camp after Midnight Friday. If you arrive later than that you will have to carry your gear into camp. There is NO exception for this. If you need to leave early for any reason gear has to be carried out, see me at Brigade HQ and we will TRY to get help on moving gear for emergencies. Vehicles will not be allowed back in until 4 pm Sunday.
- If you forget to print the parking pass that was sent with your registration confirmation there will be passes available at registration.
- No RVs or modern camping is allowed in reenactor parking. Instead, the spectator parking lot should be used.




Company A will be assigned Street #7 (This may differ from the map on site)

Company B will be assigned Street #8

- ABSOLUTELY NO digging of fire pits. Fires may be built above ground, and must be watched at all times.
- PLEASE KEEP CAMP POLICED AT ALL TIMES, INCLUDING DURING COOKING. Open your items in your tent or keep something handy to keep it covered up. THE EVENT IS EXPECTING SPECTATORS NUMBERING IN THE THOUSANDS. The last thing we all want are pictures out there with a camp that looks bad.
- Participants are required to remain dressed out in period appropriate clothing for the duration of the event.



### Locations of amenities

- Re-enactor Medical – will be staffed by the brigade headquarters.
- Firewood – located around the camps.
- Modern bathrooms/ Port-o-johns are going to be spread around the event.
- Straw – will not be available. If you need some, please bring your own.
- Water locations – will be accessible either at the spicket provided at the end of the streets or the hose end nearer our camp.
- Ice - will be available for purchase while supplies last. \$5 for a 10 lb. bag. Ice will only be available for sale Saturday and Sunday between 9 and 4 pm.
- For anyone who hasn't been to Perryville before, there is nothing real close. The closest restaurants and grocery stores are in Danville. There is a gas station in town but make sure you have all of your meals and provisions before the event. The town of Perryville has a festival going on and traffic on Saturday and Sunday is expected to be bad.
